Legends

The entry fee for foreign drivers invited by the organizer is only a service fee (500 SEK). In this service fee electricity and other services are included.

A service fee of 10 SEK will be added.

The entry fee shall be paid at the same time as the entry is done.

If the driver enters more classes a fee of 600 SEK/vehicle has to be paid.

500 SEK extra has to be paid if the entry is made later than August 8th.

If this is not followed a penalty on 500 SEK will be given out.

21. Tests: Friday the 7th of September. See the attached time schedule. The fee for the test is

200 SEK for all classes.

22. Electricity: Access to 220VAC is included in the service fee. You will need a 240 V (CEE)

adaptor.

23. Excuse: If you cannot attend, you have to inform the organizer before the 12th of August 2018.

If you do it later than the 12^{th} of August 2018, ARC will keep 1200 SE administrative

costs. Friday's tests = no refund

24. Registration: When arriving at the track the driver shall report to the secretariat (2nd floor in the

main building). The driver have to show valid identification, license, and if

applicable a club membership card and medical report.

25. Extra PM: Announced on the official notice board at the secretariat. (2nd floor in the main

building)

26. Transponder: Transponder of type AMB is required. Transponder id shall be noted on application form.

Renting of transponder is possible at the track. Pick-up at timekeeping office before first

practice.

27. Scrutineering: Friday 7/9, 17.00-20.00

Saturday 8/9, 07.00-11.00

Inspection in the scrutineering hall "Besiktning" under the paddock grandstand. The

vehicle has to be scrutinised and approved before qualifying.

28. Drivers Briefing: With compulsory presence will be announced in the PM1

29. Practice: Drivers who has not done 5 full laps of the circuit can be prevented from starting.

30. Pole Position: Pole position is on the left side of the track in the running direction or according to

respective class regulaton.

31. Official language: Swedish with English as help.

32. Prize ceremony: Cups will be given to the first three drivers in each heat.

The cups will be given after each heat.

33. Safety car: The organiser has the right to use safety car during practises/races, and in

exceptional cases in the starts.



34. Victory car: NO

35. Passes: Each driver gets 4 entry passes and 1 car pass. Extra car passes cost 50 SEK each. The

Vehicle parking is outside the pit. Cost for extra additional pitline passes 300 SEK each.

36. Pit-boxes: There are 19 pit boxes available for hire. For information contact SRW

37. Cancellation: Cancellation of the meeting by force majeure or other reason, will be announced to the

drivers 24 hours before the start of scrutineering.

38. Protest fee: According to SBF regulations = 3000 SEK.

39. Noise: Maximum noise level is 95 dBA (drive-by measurement) according to method specified by

Organisers. Method specified by organiser superseedes method which is specified in national

ASN regulations for noise measurement.

NB! Exceeding of the specified noise level results in a" Technical Flag" and a possible

exclusion of the meeting. No refund of the application fee will be accepted Cars/Drivers will be

notified also during and after Friday test sessions.

40. Exit from track: When exiting the track into the pits, keep to the left after "Hansen-curve" through the

"Karusellen-curve". The white line before the exit must not be crossed. If the line is

crossed there will be a penalty.

41. Recycling centre: There is a recycling centre behind the hangar. Barrels, tyres and petrol must not be left

behind. Team/driver who leave barrels, tyres or liquids/oils will be charged 1000 SEK.

42. Food & drinks: Restaurant and kiosk will be open during the weekend.

43. Pits: Only people with approved passes are allowed in the pits.

Age limit: 15 years old. Strollers, pets etc is not allowed. Smoking is not allowed

in the pits or in the boxes. Speed limit is 50 km/h

44. Line-up: The Line-up area is placed in the pit area at the footbridge/box 23. Heat participants

has to be there at least 20 min before the announced starting time of the heat.

45. Parc fermé is placed in front of the paddock grandstand (Scrutineering). All cars have

to park there directly after the race and until the protest time is up. The scrutineering

staff will let you know when this time is up.

46. Paddock: Directions from the Paddock staff must be followed at all times. Trailers and other transport

vehicles must be parked in specified areas only! Paddock aisles <u>must be kept clear at all times</u> for safety reasons. Wrongly parked vehicles will be towed at the expense of the owner and

owner is fully responsable for all damages to the vehicle caused by the removal.

Required paddock space shall be specified on application form.

47. Start numbers: Start number according to FIA's "International Sporting Code" has to be

placed on the car when the scrutineering starts. The organiser has the right to, if

necessary, assign new start numbers to cars with fixed start numbers
